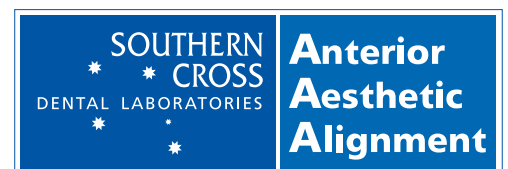

INVISALIGN MODULES 1-7 (Day)

Module 1. Integrating an alignment phase into Aesthetic Dentistry

Participants are taught how to recognise and classify aesthetically compromised patients with a particular accent on sources of visual tension. The opportunity to deliver to patients an option to unravel crowded dentitions or to close diastemas with a high degree of predictability without fixed braces is demonstrated using Invisalign aligners.

Module 2. Tooth movements, space creation and patient selection

Understanding how teeth move with removable aligners is essential to mastering Invisalign®. Movements from highly predictable, somewhat predictable and less predictable positions are discussed in tandem with the necessity of providing sufficient space into which the teeth can move. Patient selection becomes simplified when these concepts are clearly understood.

Module 3. Alignment 101 (Initial Record Taking)

Accurate impression taking is fundamental to success with Invisalign®. Careful consideration is given to reinforce the suggested impression process and taking high quality radiographic and photographic records. Order forms must be completed and submitted with a view to total integration with the aesthetic outcome required.

Module 4. Introduction to ClinCheck® and VPS (Virtual Practice Site)

Each participant learns how to use the sophisticated ClinCheck® software within their own VPS (Virtual Practice Site). Modification, treatment approval and manipulation of the animation of the proposed movements is demonstrated in detail.

Module 5. Alignment 102 (IPR , Attachments and Delivery)

The dentist then learns about the philosophy and clinical procedures behind attachments and why they are so critical to success. Consideration of when and where to perform IPR (interproximal reduction) is discussed, along with how to deliver the aligners to their patients. A detailed list of instructions for each patient is provided.

Module 6. Alignment 103 (Monitoring)

Monitoring the alignment stage to ensure that the process is tracking well is an essential part of the skills required by the dentist. A thorough understanding of what can go wrong and how to alleviate it is presented here.

Module 7. Invisalign® Treatment Gallery

Participants are presented with a series of Invisalign® patient treatments that have been completed which demonstrate what can be achieved when an alignment phase is integrated into aesthetic dentistry. This aids dentists in presenting treatment plans and understanding the likely length of treatment for each patient.

2 CLINICAL WORKSHOP I (Day)

Module 8. Clinical Workshop I

Participants work together to assess all patients from each dentist. The critical skills required for achieving predictable outcomes are focused upon in this clinical setting and allows each dentist the rare opportunity to treat a multitude of Invisalign® treatments in a clinical setting immediately. Patient treatment assessment, impression taking, bite registrations and photographic records are mastered by the end of this unique, in vivo workshop.



Module 9. Marketing

This module concentrates on how to institute simple internal marketing initiatives in your practice including typodonts, brochures and posters are discussed and use of your own Invisalign website is presented.

3 CLIN-CHECK REVIEW & INTRO TO INTRA-ORAL SCANNING (Day)

Module 10. Clin-Check Review of Your Case, an Introduction to Intra-oral Scanning and FAQs

This 4.5 hour seminar is critical for all participants as each case treated clinically on Day II is examined in the Clin-Check software and we see just how the theory of sequential aligners works in real time.

Each case is assessed again and participants not only learn how to manipulate the software but they also develop a feel for how long each case will take, how space is created using expansion, IPR, proclination, extraction and distalisation. Programming for IPR and composite attachments can be examined closely on each patient.

Additionally, a discussion on intra-oral scanners and FAQs from the course thus far is conducted.



4 CLINICAL WORKSHOP II (Day)

Module I I. Clinical Workshop II

(Approximately 2 months after Day 1 & 2)

When your patient is ready for aligner delivery, attachments and/or interproximal reduction (IPR), (8-12 weeks after Day 1 & 3), SCDL's clinical team visits your practice to instruct and guide you on the following;

- Try-in attachment template



- Bonding of attachments



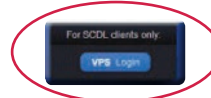
- Interproximal Reduction - IPR (if required)



- ClinCheck® software setup & training



- VPS (Virtual Practice Site) workshop & front office protocols



- Reinforcement of compliance & oral hygiene is also discussed in tandem with a strict vigilance for collisions in crowding treatments.

5 INVISALIGN MODULES 11 -15 (day)

(Approximately 4 months after Day 1 & 2. Day 5 is held in Sydney for all attendees except Perth, see date and venue sheet attached).

Module 12. Update on progress of Invisalign® treatments

Each participant is given the opportunity to discuss the progress of their 1st patient treatment. Further discussion on each part of the process thus far is encouraged.

Module 13. Monitoring, Troubleshooting, Mid Course Corrections & Refinements

The importance of vigilance is emphasised and the ramifications of noncompliance and lack of monitoring is demonstrated. Recovering from poor fitting aligners and unpredictable movements are discussed, including mid-course corrections and refinements.



Module 14. Retention

Whilst moving the teeth into an idyllic position is the fundamental reason to undertake treatment, retaining this position is just as important. An understanding of when and why we use fixed or removable retention is covered in depth in this module.



Module 15. Penn Composite Stent

A unique delivery system for the fabrication of morphologically ideal direct composite veneers is demonstrated. The combination of this technique with Invisalign or as a stand-alone process is discussed.

HOW TO BECOME QUALIFIED TO PRESCRIBE INVISALIGN

Participants are required to bring a patient to both Clinical Workshop days, who is deemed suitable to undergo treatment. Ideal patients are adults with Class I molar relationships with anterior crowding or spacing, caries free and a sound periodontal status (suitable patients to the right).



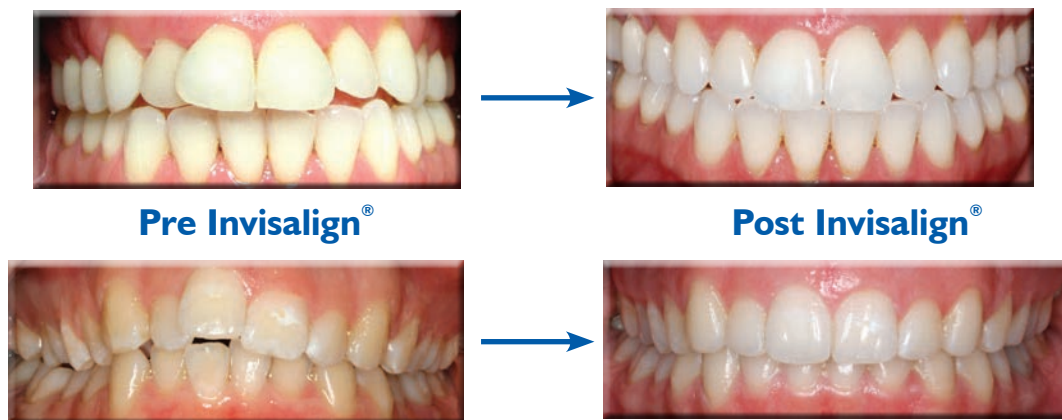
